Available in 3 standard sizes with 60x60cm and 50x50cm doubles Jutland fibre cement slates allow even the most complex of roofs to be installed in compliance with British Standard Codes of Practice and Building Regulations. Jutland slates come pre-holed, are easy to handle and install, Jutland slate is the economic alternative to natural roofing materials.
